Registration: Please report to reception at the Training Centre on the first morning of your course. Registration is open between 8:15 – 9:00am.

what time will my course finish in the afternoon?

Most courses tend to finish between 4pm and 5pm in the afternoon. Your course trainer will discuss times with you and may alter timings to suit the course and the class as a whole. If your course includes evening sessions or self-study, your trainer will explain this on your first day.

Is there a dress code?

There is no dress code, but most learners attending courses at Eastwood Park tend to dress in 'smart-casual'. It is important to be comfortable whilst undertaking the practical elements of your course. Please also wear appropriate footwear. If there are any special PPE requirements, this will be stated in your joining instructions email.
